

WHAT IS ANTIFA?



ANTIFA IS AN ABBREVIATION OF ANTIFASCHISTISCHE AKTION, ORIGINALLY SET UP BY THE GERMAN COMMUNIST PARTY IN 1932 TO OPPOSE THE NAZIS.




IN THE 1980S, THE ANTIFASCHISTISCHE AKTION WAS REVIVED BY AUTONOMISTS AND ANARCHISTS IN WEST GERMANY TO COUNTER A GROWING FAR RIGHT, WITH NO CONNECTION TO THE ORIGINAL COMMUNIST PARTY ORGANIZATION. TODAY, MANY GROUPS USE VARIATIONS OF THE ORIGINAL ANTIFA LOGO DESIGNED BY MAX KIELSON & MAX GEBHARD.





ANTIFA IS CHARACTERIZED BY MILITANT DIRECT ACTION AGAINST THE FAR RIGHT AND A RADICAL ANTI-CAPITALIST ANALYSIS. ORGANIZED AS AUTONOMOUS AND DECENTRALIZED GROUPS, ANTIFA SEE IT AS NECESSARY TO CONFRONT FASCISTS BOTH IDEOLOGICALLY AND PHYSICALLY. THEY ALSO WORK TO CREATE ANTI-FASCIST AND ANTI-RACIST CULTURE.

ANTIFA NOT ONLY **MOBILIZES** AGAINST **FASCIST** AND **NEO-NAZI** GROUPS BUT ALSO FAR RIGHT MOVEMENTS THAT SHARE MANY OF THE SAME **GOALS** AS FASCISTS (SUCH AS THE **KU KLUX KLAN**, FOR EXAMPLE).



TODAY, ANTIFA IS STILL USED AS AN ABBREVIATION FOR ANTI-FASCIST ACTION GROUPS BUT ALSO REFERS TO MILITANT ANTI-FASCISTS IN GENERAL.

THE FASCI OF ROME AND ITALY:

THE FIRST FASCIST AND ANTI-FASCIST MOVEMENTS



THE FIRST **FASCIST** GROUPS AROSE IN ITALY DURING WW1. THEIR SUPREME LEADER WOULD BE **BENITO MUSSOLINI**. HE WAS REFERRED TO AS "IL DUCE" (THE LEADER).

AT THE TIME, MUSSOLINI WAS A MEMBER OF THE ITALIAN SOCIALIST PARTY (P.S.I.). A SKILLED WRITER AND SPEAKER, HE WAS THE EDITOR OF THE P.S.I.'S MAIN NEWSPAPER, AVANTI!

THAT YEAR, HE WAS **KICKED OUT** OF



THE P.S.I. HE SET UP A FASCIST GROUP IN MILAN AND BEGAN PUBLISHING HIS OWN NEWSPAPER.

AT THIS TIME, BIG INDUSTRIALISTS AND BANKS BEGAN TO FUND MUSSOLINI FOR HIS

PRO-WAR AND NATIONALIST AIMS,


IN ARMS PRODUCTION).

NEUTRALITY IN THE WAR.








IN 1915, HOWEVER, MUSSOLINI WAS **DRAFTED** INTO THE ARMY AND SENT TO THE **FRONT**.

HE SERVED IN AN INFANTRY REGIMENT AND SAW COMBAT ALONG THE ITALIAN AND AUSTRIA-HUNGARIAN BORDER.



POST-WAR ITALY FACED A SOCIO-ECONOMIC CRISIS: MASSIVE DEBT, HIGH UNEMPLOYMENT, POVERTY, AND 3 MILLION DEMOBILIZED SOLDIERS.



INSPIRED BY THE **1917 RUSSIAN REVOLUTION**, RADICALS ACROSS EUROPE SAW THESE CRISES AS OPPORTUNITIES FOR **REVOLUTIONS**.



MILLIONS OF WORKERS JOINED COMMUNIST, SOCIALIST OR ANARCHIST GROUPS. A WAVE OF REBELLION SWEPT ACROSS EUROPE.

THE SOCIALIST PARTY GREW FROM 50,000 IN 1914 TO OVER 200,000 IN 1919. DURING ELECTIONS IN 1919, THE P.S.I. WON 1.8 MILLION VOTES (32%). IF NOT FOR THE INABILITY TO FORM A COALITION, THE P.S.I. WOULD HAVE WON.






ALONGSIDE **STRIKES** AND **OCCUPATIONS**, RADICALS **GAINED CONTROL** OF MUNICIPAL GOVERNMENTS, LABOUR EXCHANGES, AND PEASANT UNIONS. THEY ALSO SET UP CO-OPS, SPORTS CLUBS AND TAVERNS. DESPITE SOME **STREET FIGHTING**, ALMOST ALL THESE ACHIEVEMENTS WERE MADE THROUGH **LEGAL MEANS**.









The shocking images of neo-Nazis marching in Charlottesville, North Carolina, in the summer of 2017 linger, but so do those of the passionate anti-fascist protestors who risked their lives to do the right thing. In this stirring graphic non-fiction book by the author of *The 500 Years of Resistance Comic Book*, Gord Hill looks at the history of fascism over the last 100 years, and the concurrent antifa movements that have worked fastidiously to topple it.

Fascism is a relatively new political ideology, yet in its short history some of the greatest atrocities against humanity have been carried out in its name. Its poisonous roots have taken hold in every region of the world, from its beginnings in post–World War I Italy, through Nazi Germany, Franco's Spain, and the KKK in America. And today, emboldened by the American president, fascism is alive and well again. At the same time, antifa activists have proven, throughout history and again today, that the spirit of resistance is alive and well, and necessary.

In *The Antifa Comic Book*, Gord Hill documents these powerful moments of conflict and confrontation with a perceptive eye and a powerful sense of resolve.
